

Claim Support Matrix

What I can show publicly, what stays private, and what I can walk through live.

Context: I want strong claims to be checkable without turning a portfolio into a data leak.

Why This Exists

- Strong claims should have support. They also should not force me to publish company records.
- This matrix is my boundary: public evidence, private proof, and live walkthrough material.

Public Proof

- CVs, sanitized case studies, recreated dashboard previews, architecture notes, and proof memos.
- These show the thinking and operating pattern without exposing sensitive records.

Private Proof

- Close files, cash models, workpapers, vendor/tax support, dashboard details, QBO exports, wallet labels, transaction rows, and internal records.

Live Walkthrough

- I can walk through assumptions, controls, review status, source-system logic, and how I would handle exceptions.

Public version: methodology and judgment only. I can walk through examples live; raw company files stay private.
